- Your video can be an independent investigation into Tablet usage in the classroom, or it may be affiliated with/ based on a paper or poster submission to the WIPTe conference www.wipte.org.
- A willingness by the producer of the video to become a reference for those investigating Tablet PC's in the learning environment by allowing the video to become a key online artifact in helping others to get better teaching and learning outcomes with this technology.

Also, by submitting to the WIPTe Video Contest the submitter acknowledges that they retain sufficient rights to allow WIPTe to become a non-exclusive distributor of the video as submitted for the 2009 WIPTe Video Contest.
